

KBC ATTIRE POLICY

Members attention is drawn to the Bowls NSW Association Event Attire Policy as follows:

All Bowls NSW Association Events

All Players and Officials shall be required to be attired in compliance with the RNSWBA Ltd attire policy.

In an Association Event played in a Team or Side format, all members of the Team or Side must be similarly attired.

Bowls Australia logo is mandatory on shirts, jackets and vests.

Penalty for Non-Compliance with Association Event Policy is disqualification.

KBC BOWLS CLUB INTERPRETATION

It is required that members **must** comply with the above dress requirements when playing in pennant games, major singles, pairs, triples and fours competition games. For uniformity the Club shirt **must** be worn for Pennant games.

KBC has also decided that the above dress requirements be met when representing the club in the Mid-Week Triples competition, Cyril South games, and Inter-Club Painting games notwithstanding they are not classified as Association events.

In all other games, which the club classifies as Social Bowls, the current Dress Policy is that Smart Casual attire may be worn. Playing shirts can be coloured and the style can be Polo or 'button up' with either long or short sleeves but must have an attached collar. Blue denim jeans style trousers are not acceptable as Smart Casual.
