



Barefoot Bowls, Mini-comp

Enjoy a game of bowls with friends in the cool of the evening, play the fun Jack Attack format.

Jack Attack is Bowls Australia's social-competitive short version of bowls that can be enjoyed by new and experienced players. It is similar to barefoot bowls in a mini-comp format (2 sets of 5 ends).

Each team is made up of 3 to 6 players, with 3 playing at any given time, and substitutions allowed. Get a team of 3 (plus reserves) together or just register yourself and we'll put you in a team. Everyone plays one game per week.

How Jack Attack works

Below are the guidelines of how Jack Attack is played:

- 2 bowl triples
 - Substitutions permitted
 - 2 sets of 5 ends with a sudden death tie-breaker if needed
 - Approximately 60-75 minutes in duration for a match

- Players can participate in consecutive order or they can bowl out of turn.
 - The jack is placed wherever the team wants to from the mat.
 - All players remain at the mat end to ensure the social atmosphere is maintained.
 - Closest bowl scores one point and additional closest bowls from the same team score additional points.
 - Each team gets to have one power-play per set.
 - Jack in the ditch is re-spotted to the 'T'
 - Result of each end is declared by the coordinator
