PRIVACY POLICY

Killara Bowling Club Ltd understands that privacy of information is important and is committed to safe-guarding the personal information provided by our Members, Visitors and Staff. We are subject to the Privacy Act 1988 and it is our policy is to comply with all aspects of this legislation.

In our commitment to protecting your privacy, any Member, Director, or Staff member who misuses this information will face disciplinary action as determined by the Board.

The Club will collect general information about you such as your name, residential address, email address and other contact details when you apply for membership. Contact information is required under the Corporations and/or Registered Clubs Act.

You may be asked for certain information at the time of applying for membership, such as proof of identity. If this information is not provided we may not be able to accept your membership application.

We will not use personal information for any purpose not disclosed at the time of collection and we will not disclose your personal information unless there is a threat to life, health or safety or it is required by law.

We will only use your personal information:

- To maintain your membership of the Club
- Only for essential primary functions of the Club or a directly related purpose, or for another purpose with your consent
- In accordance with the Club's Constitution
- In accordance with Corporations Law and the Registered Clubs Act

Your personal information may, with your permission, be used by the Club for Club marketing purposes.

You have the right to access the personal information that we hold about you.
